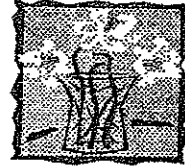


Landscape & Horticulture Management Syllabus & Conduct Contract



Welcome! This class is designed for students interested in landscape and plant production. The purpose of this course is to instruct you on the landscape and horticulture industry, fundamentals of design, and the use of plant in the world around us.

Courses Objectives: To proficiently demonstrate an understanding of the fundamental and principles of plant propagation and care, plant identification, landscape design and installation.
